

Routt Catholic High School Scholarships Available For Incoming Senior Students

Please note: all of the scholarships described on this page are offered for senior students, but they aren't necessarily offered to only senior students. Most scholarships are open to students spanning different years in high school, but this is a quick and easy view of all those scholarships for which seniors are eligible.

Scholarships are awarded to recipients on an annual basis using the criteria indicated by the scholarship donor. General Tuition scholarships are awarded based on the information the school receives from FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. Routt encourages all families to submit an application online to FACTS. Applications or essays are only required for a scholarship if indicated. A complete listing may be found on the school's website, www.routtcatholic.com. **The deadline for the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment and any additional scholarship essays or applications is April 15.**

The following scholarships are **need-based** and **require** that you complete the Grant & Aid Management application in the FACTS system.
